PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

The AFA Medal will be shipped, free of charge, directly to the PAS of the AFROTC Detachment. Upon receipt of the Medal and elements, the PAS submits a **Written Invitation** to the President of the AFA Chapter located in the geographical area of the AFROTC Detachment and provides time, date and location wherein presentation of the AFA Medal will take place. The AFA Chapter President and/or his designated representative will be in attendance to make the presentation of the Medal to the Outstanding Junior Year (AS-300) Cadet of the Detachment.
