Civil Air Patrol Educator Grant Guidelines

The Civil Air Patrol Unit Grant is funded by the Aerospace Education Council of the Air Force Association and managed by the Civil Air Patrol (CAP) Headquarters. AFA takes great pride in recognizing the outstanding achievements of CAP educators who are preparing our youth to meet the technological and scientific challenges of the 21st Century.

Requirements/Selection Criteria

- 1 – Classroom teachers who are Aerospace Education Members or CAP members are eligible to receive one grant every other year.
- 2 – Each school is limited to two grants every other year.
- 3 – Grants cannot exceed \$250 per request.
- 4 – Grants must be used for aerospace education-related items and activities such as rockets and airplane materials, books, video-tapes/DVDs, software, or field trips to an aerospace museum, Air Force Base or other aerospace facility.
- 5 – Grant must benefit an entire class and may not be used for activities that only benefit a single student (such as individual flying instruction).
- 6 – Grant recipients must file a follow-up report with the Aerospace Education Division (HQ CAP/ETA) at CAP National Headquarters explaining how the AFA grant helped them promote aerospace education in their classroom..
